SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES - 2026

1. APPLICATION FEE

A non-refundable application fee of \$250 is charged for each application of enrolment. This covers the administration cost associated with enrolment. There has been no increase applied to this fee. The Application fee is not credited towards Tuition Fees.

2. ENROLMENT FEES

A non-refundable enrolment fee of \$1,500 must accompany the acceptance of an Offer of Confirmed Enrolment. There has been no increase applied to this fee. The Enrolment fee is not credited towards Tuition Fees.

3. ANNUAL TUITION FEES – PER STUDENT

The annual tuition fees for 2026 will be billed once at the beginning of the year. Most additional charges are incorporated into the annual tuition fee; however, there are some minor exceptions depending on your son's chosen activities or programs. Items that may incur separate charges include but are not limited to: Duke of Edinburgh programs, certain excursions/in-school activities, interstate and overseas tours/trips, musical instrument hire, optional music tuition and specialised equipment or uniform.

4. SIBLING DISCOUNT

Discount on tuition fees is available for the second child in a family (10%), the third child (20%) and the fourth and subsequent children (40%) providing that the children are attending the College simultaneously.

5. BUILDING FUND (TAX DEDUCTIBLE)

A Capital Levy of \$750 per annum is charged to each family account to support the ongoing improvements to our existing buildings. There has been no increase applied to this levy.

Those families who have the financial capacity to do so are invited to contribute to the Building Fund above this level. The College relies upon contributions to the Building Fund to finance its building and refurbishment program. Contributions to the Building Fund are tax deductible.

6. PAYMENT METHOD

For the payment of school fees, two options are available:

1. Paying full fees upfront - Due Friday 27 February 2026
2. Paying via Instalments (This requires parents to sign up to a School Easy Pay Direct Debit payment plan).

Any additional ad hoc charges that may arise will be invoiced and added to any existing payment schedule.

Paying by Instalments:

Your annual billing will include instructions on how to set up a Direct Debit. The School Easy Pay direct debit system within TASS Parent Lounge is a secure, paperless direct debit platform providing increased flexibility, allowing families to manage and track fee payments throughout the year.

Direct Debit schedule is required to be set up via the TASS Parent Lounge. You can set up your direct debit to ensure payments are made Fortnightly, Monthly or Termly via Credit Card, Debit Card or nominating a bank account.

Due Date for first payment:

Fortnightly	Friday 13 February 2026
Monthly	Friday 27 February 2026
Termly	Friday 27 February 2026

All accounts must be settled in full by **Friday 6 November 2026**. Failure to settle account in full by the due date, will attract an administrative fee of \$100.

Where accounts are paid termly, the due dates are below and payment is required in full.

Surcharges apply to payments at time of processing. The College was successful in negotiating a reduction in 2026 rates by 0.05%

If your direct debit fails on the date payment is due, then it will be reprocessed three days after the due date. A reprocessing fee of \$20 will be applied.

If parents wish to withdraw a Student from the College, advance notice of not less than one (1) full term must be given. If the required notice of withdrawal of a student is not given, the parent must pay any remaining fees for the current term in addition to fees for the following term.
