Terms of Reference

- Familiarisation with the unique context and tradition of St Patrick's College,
 Strathfield as a Catholic School in the Edmund Rice tradition

Scope:

- Review of College documentation, policies and practice, as appropriate, to assure conformity with all aspects of the Charter
- Monitoring the formation opportunities for the College community
- Considering other matters referred by the School Advisory Council or the Principal

Core Membership

- One School Advisory Council Member who will act as the Chair
- College Principal
- A member of the College Executive (being the Director of Identity)
- A representative of Parents
- A representative of Old Boys
- Other members by invitation
